<p>Errors from previous lesson:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are all struggling to grasp the 1:1:1 doubling rule. Incorrect reading spelling ex: spinned/spined, blotted/bloted • Students are still working to read words with different sounds of suffix - ed efficiently 	
<p>Objective: To reinforce the 1:1:1 doubling rule, practice reading words with suffix -ed</p>

<p>a(apple, baby), e(eskimo, zero), i(igloo, spider), o(octopus, pony), u(umbrella, music) a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e, u-e (cube, rule) y (my, candy) -ck, -tch</p> <p>Suffixes: -s, -ing, -ed, -ful, -less, -er, -est</p>	
<p>Words: Read. Then students must find word based on a given meaning.</p> <p>Shipped snaped flatter gladest stubed quiter hidding blotting hiding shiped Quilter blotting stubbed quitter snapped gladdest bloting shipped trimmed flater</p>
